Race day registration and check-in begins at 7:30 a.m. REGISTRATION WILL END PROMPTLY AT 8:50 a.m. Athletes are strongly ENCOURAGED TO PRE-REGISTER by mail or online at www.active.com to avoid waiting in line on race day and to guarantee a race t-shirt. ***T-shirts will not be guaranteed for forms received after Friday, March 19.*** NO REFUNDS FOR EVENTS ENTERED AND NOT RUN.

PACKET PICK-UP: Race packets with T-shirts and numbers will be provided at the Packet Pick-Up party from 6-10 p.m. Friday, March 26 at Shore Break on Shore Drive in Virginia Beach, or at the Registration Table on Race Day.

RACE ROUTE: The race will be run on the boardwalk, beginning and ending near the 31st Street Park.

Age categories are as follows: 19 and under; 20-29; 20-39, 40-49; and 50 and over. Awards will be presented by our honored guest and Warrior of the Day, Jason C.
